Law on Remuneration of Labor in Public Institutions is a standalone document in Georgia; rather, the principles of remuneration for public sector employees are covered under the broader Labor Code of Georgia, which establishes general labor laws, and through other relevant legislation and regulations governing specific types of employment, like civil service and public institutions. Key aspects of remuneration in the public sector, including pay, allowances, and employment conditions, are detailed in ministerial orders and decrees specific to each institution or sector.
