

The Law of Georgia on the "Red List" and "Red Book" of Georgia, is a legal framework that establishes rules for identifying, compiling, and maintaining the official Red List and Red Book of Georgia, which catalogue endangered species of plants and animals. This law prohibits the harmful exploitation and significant disruption of listed species and their habitats, with the primary goal of protecting endangered species, preserving biodiversity, and managing wildlife sustainably.
